What?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social security information
- Account balance and transaction history
- Credit history and employment information

How?

All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons 7 Mortgage, LLC chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account – unless you tell us otherwise.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  7 Mortgage, LLC does share with our affiliates
Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  7 Mortgage, LLC does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.  7 Mortgage, LLC does jointly market.

## Other Important Information

**Vermont Residents Only:** We will not disclose information about your creditworthiness to our affiliates and we will not disclose your personal information, financial information, credit report or health information to nonaffiliated third parties to market to you, other than as permitted by Vermont law, unless you authorize us to make those disclosures.
